

Crestwood Preparatory College Lunch Program **Guidelines**

Programs: All programs are open only to Crestwood Preparatory College students enrolled in Grade 7 and 8.

Dates: Classes are on Wednesdays commencing September 30th and run eight (8) weeks ending on Wednesday, November 18, 2009

Time: Lunchtime program run from 11:35 am – 12:20 pm. The students are able to eat lunch in the classroom but must take all garbage with them.

Registration:

All students should return the completed form with payment directly to the office as soon as possible before the closing date. A cheque payable to “Crestwood Preparatory College Parents’ Association” (CPCPA), should accompany one form for each child. Additional registration forms will be available in the office. **Registration will be on a first-come first-serve basis.**

Deadline for registration is Friday, September 25th, 2009

Placement:

Wherever possible, children will be placed in their activity unless the class is filled. Confirmation of all spots will be sent to the parents via e-mail so please ensure this is provided on the application form.

Fees: See individual programs.

Method of Payment: Cheque, payable to “Crestwood Preparatory College Parent’s Association” (CCPCA).

Refunds: As soon as a child is registered in a particular program, registration fees cannot be refunded. Our commitment to our instructors is based on the number of students enrolled in a class.

Learn to be a Chess Wiz:

This is not just an ordinary chess and math club you might be used to. The Chess Course will be taught by Yuri "Yuri" Lebedev, who is a coach who has successfully coached at Owen for years and has also taught at Montessori, Crescent and Upper Canada College.
